I used an old cowboy hat I didn't bother with a red one, I just used what I had) and taped yard to the inside back of it. I braided the yard and used the same color yellow ribbon to tie it as jessie had..

She wore a white shirt and blue jeans. My daughter LOVES jessie in a big way and so I just copied what was on the doll. I used a sharpie marker and a white trash bag to color chaps with a cow hide pattern and taped them on to the front of the jeans using black and white duct tape according to the pattern i had made to keep it on. I used fringe at the bottom of the chaps.

On the chest i used yellow construction paper with a red marker to draw the design. On the cuffs i used the yellow construction paper with red marker squiggles, and some white copy paper fringed and taped on the shirt. I didn't bother with a belt but i did draw a steer head with a brown crayon again using the yellow paper and taped that on as a belt buckle. I didn't have a white button down long sleeved shirt so i turned one inside out that had a picture on it, then i used the copy paper to make buttons.
